8. Every month one student from each Department is selected on the basis of her academic achievement and she is called as ‘the Star of the Month’ of the Department.
9. Stress free classes were conducted on a regular basis to the students and made them be free from all the personal clutches during covid 19 affected time.
10. **International Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC):** IQAC was started in our college. Rev.Sr.Arul Jothi, CIC was appointed as the coordinator. The team started their work efficiency and documenting the five years activities of the various Departments in the college. The management allotted separate room and provided Computers with printout for IQAC.
11. **ACPR Initiative:** Our College initiated the career oriented course on Multimedia for Life Long Learning by Colloborating with Arrupe Centre for policy Research, Arul Anandar College, Karumattur.
